



Researchers Symposium

Goal

Objective of INDICON 2014 Researchers Symposium is to provide an opportunity for researchers including Ph. D scholars and aspirants to showcase/discuss their in-progress research / research problems identified/state of the art and idea incubation. It is a symposium for researchers and participants will get an opportunity to have detailed discussion with symposium attendees/session chairs and obtain feedbacks/ critical evaluation of their work. Symposium also welcomes live demos / demonstrations as a part of their presentation. It is good opportunity for researchers to discuss their goals, methods, and results at an early stage in their research.

Scope

Technical scope of the Researcher Symposium is the same as INDICON 2014 conference. Participants can be Ph. D scholars/ aspirants/ researchers. If the participant is Ph. D scholar then he/she should be registered Ph. D student in the university OR with completion of formulating a topic for their doctoral dissertation OR are on the verge of completing a thesis proposal.

Evaluation

The Researchers Symposium Committee will select presenters using the following criteria:

- The potential quality of the research.
- Its relevance to the theme of INDICON 2014.
- Quality of the research abstract.
- Diversity of background, research topics and approaches.

How to Submit

To apply as a presenter in the Researchers Symposium, you should prepare a submission consisting of two parts, both of which must be submitted by the submission deadline.

Part 1: (Research Abstract)

The submission should not exceed 4 pages authored by researcher and must include:

- Abstract
- The research problem that you are targeting with justification of its importance
- Discussion on related and prior work explaining why this has not solved the problem
- A sketch of the proposed approach or solution
- The expected contributions of your dissertation research
- Progress you have made so far in solving the stated problem
- The methods you are using or will use to carry out your research
- A plan for evaluating your work
- A list of any publications (appeared, accepted or submitted) for which the researcher is an author.

Part 2 (Letter of Recommendation)

A letter of recommendation duly signed by the Ph. D supervisor / employer / mentor must be submitted which should include name of the researcher, name of the Ph. D supervisor/employer/mentor, and an expected date for dissertation submission if participant is Ph. D scholar.

Acceptance

Participant must register for the Researchers Symposium to present their work. The abstracts will be available to participants in the form of booklet during Researchers Symposium. Researchers Symposium of INDICON 2014 will also issue the certificate of participation to all the presenters and participants. The presenters will get 20 minutes time including discussion and outline of the presentation must include:

- Introduction
- Motivation
- Related works
- Problem Formulated
- Methodology
- Publication (If any)
- Conclusions
